

Swedish 'Mini' Husky Expedition



For those who want an active winter holiday....here you can be part of all the work and life at a sled dog kennel with lots of Siberian Huskies. Come with us on a tour in the beautiful Swedish mountains with your own team of huskies who along with your guide will give you the experience of a lifetime.

Day 1

Transfer to Husky Lodge. Meet the dogs and learn how to harness them and technique of sledding. Over dinner we look at the map of our forthcoming trip and learn how to navigate with both compass and GPS.

Day 2

We pack the car and set off for the mountains – approximately 40km. Then the adventure begins as we go through the breathtaking magnificent mountains and wilderness. When we see a nice spot, we will stop for lunch. We then carry on until it is time to set up camp. Everybody helps with this. Dinner under the open sky!

Day 3

We wake up to the silence of the mountains. First we feed the dogs and then have our own breakfast. It is a bit uphill today so we need to help the dogs but the views are definitely worth it! The dogs get extra snacks today for their hard work. Together we make dinner, some of us cooking, some of us melting snow for us and the dogs.

Day 4

Today as always we will do what the weather allows us. The weather can change fast in the mountains from blue sky and sun to storm and blizzard. Every day is different and this makes the trip so special. At the end of the day we say goodbye to the mountains and head back to the Husky Lodge by car. We can have a shower and then our last dinner together where we can share our experiences and maybe some photos too!

Day 5

After breakfast it is time to say goodbye to your lovely huskies, the guide & Jämtland. Transfer to airport.



Cost: £1275 per person

Duration: 5 days, 4 nights

Group size: 2 to 4 persons

Included:

2 nights in double room at the Husky Lodge (arrival and departure)
2 nights in tent or mountain cabin
3 days of dog sledding with your own team in the mountains
All meals and special outer clothing including sleeping bag/mattress
Guide on the tours and activities
Participation in the daily care of the dogs
Transfer from airport or train station

Not Included:

Flights, travel insurance, alcohol, items of a personal nature.

The 'Husky Lodge'

Located by the sled dog kennels, the lodge is next to the guides' home. The lodge is in modern Swedish country style and has been renovated in 2007. The lodge consists of 2 mini-suites for 2 persons each - with bedroom, lounge and WC. There are 2 extra beds in the guides' house, if necessary.

Options:

Spend a day and night at a Sámi village in the mountains. The sled dogs will take us to the Sámi camp. We have a nice 3 course dinner, wood fired outdoor bath, lecture by the Sámi people after breakfast the next day we continue our husky safari. Upon request only, not included, £300 per person. (minimum 4 guests).

How to get there

The sled dog kennel is located in Jämtland which is in the middle of Sweden between Åre and Östersund. Transfers are arranged from Östersund airport or Järpen train station. SAS & FlyNordic fly from Stockholm Arlanda to Östersund airport (or you can go by train). If you are flying into Trondheim, Norway you can take the "Nabotåget" to Järpen.
